Persons with developmental disabilities are about **3.5 times more likely to be diagnosed with COVID-19** compared to those without developmental disabilities.

Individuals with developmental disabilities **are twice as likely to be admitted to the hospital** and **two to three times more likely to die** than those without developmental disabilities.
